



GIFT AID DECLARATION

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue; helping your monthly subs payments to go further. It requires absolutely no input from you, other than signing the declaration to state that you are a tax payer.

This means that your £10 monthly subs payment can be turned into £12.50. That makes a significant difference to us; it doesn't cost you a penny and requires no further action from you! That is £30 more every year - just from one person's subs payments.

We want your monthly subs payments to go further, so please Gift Aid it. Just complete this form and send it back to us.

NOTES

- 1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or Capital Gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity (Scout Group) reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1.00 you give).
- 2. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the charity (Scout Group).
- 3. If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and Capital Gains equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your Declaration.
- 4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment Tax Return.
- 5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity, or ask your local Tax Office for leaflet IR65.
- 6. Please notify the charity (Scout Group) if you change your name or address.
